### **Multi-Casualty Incident**

Reports To: IC or Operations Section Chief, if established

Radio Identifier: Fire Branch

Responsibilities: Protect exposures, rescue trapped occupants, control and extinguish

the fire, and secure utilities.

Provide for the safety of responders and others

- Obtain a briefing from the IC or Ops Chief
- Don position identification vest
- Establish a work area in or adjacent to the command post
- Coordinate with IC to secure frequencies
- Communicate objectives to each assigned group/division supervisor

#### **IMMEDIATE PRIORITIES**

- Size-Up
- Protect Exposures
- Rescue Occupants
- Control/Extinguish Fire
- Secure Utilities
- Verify type and number of resources assigned, assign and reassign resources to groups, divisions, and units, and request additional resources as needed
- Maintain written accountability for all resources assigned to the Branch
- Review group/division assignments for effectiveness and modify as needed
- Provide input to IC or the Ops Chief
- Supervise branch activities
- Coordinate activities with other branches, groups, and divisions
- Provide status reports to designated to IC or Ops Chief
- Release units/personnel back to the IC or Ops Chief when no longer needed within the Branch
